 - <u>No video pieces, please.</u>
 - Original art submissions will be displayed in the library from 1/8/24-1/21/24.
 - Entries will be scanned or photographed to be published in #ZINE (if their original format is not digital.)
- All entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form.
- All entries must be submitted to Prescott Public Library's Youth Services staff or emailed to youth.services@prescott-az.gov by Friday, December 15 at 5 pm.
- Winners will be notified by January 8, 2024.
